**COUNCIL MEETING/WORK SESSION
APRIL 10, 2018**

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio was called to order on April 10, 2017 at 8:15 p.m. by Mayor David Moore. Present were: Mayor Moore, and Messrs. Glenn Drees, Jeff Halter, and Jack Lee and Ms. Melanie Hermes. Also present were: Municipal Manager Evonne Kovach and Clerk of Council Kathy Lives.

By unanimous consent, Ms. Walther was excused due to a prior commitment.

MOMENT OF SILENT REFLECTION/PRAYER PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG

After a prayer led by Mr. Drees, the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was recited.

Mr. Halter distributed information on an endorsement for the Public Library tax levy. He encouraged individual Council members to use the form to express their support for the levy.

Discussion Items

Municipal Manager – Evonne Kovach

Garbage Collection

Section 939 of the Greenhills Codified Ordinances authorizes the Village to establish reasonable and uniform regulations for the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse within the Village and to promote the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Greenhills by providing a clean and safe environment for the citizens of the Village. This clause has been used several times to correct refuse violations, including small and large amounts of refuse. She then provided a summary of the violators and types of violations that have occurred and the penalties for said violations.

Tax Valuation Issue


Most of the members of Council were in attendance at the Informational meeting on the tax valuation issue held earlier in the evening hosted by the Municipal Manager. Mayor Moore stated Finance Director Matt Sanders calculated that if the property tax re-evaluations are found valid on the approximately 76 challenged properties, the amount generated would be \$2,678.00 to the Village.
