CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Moore opened the discussion on wireless infrastructure improvements. Proposed ordinance language will be brought forth to Law Committee and then Planning Commission. Ms. Kovach indicated that the open area connecting Ireland Ave. to the Municipal Building/American Legion lot would be open to golf cart traffic beginning this summer. Improvements are being investigated to provide safe access for one golf cart at a time.

Ms. Waltherr discussed upcoming Recreation events, including Harvest Fest Community Day at the Pool and the Pioneer Day Parade.

Council congratulated and thanked Finance Director Matt Sanders as he leaves his position with the Village.
