MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor David Moore called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Messrs. Jack Lee, Glenn Drees and Jeff Halter & Ms. Maria Waltherr and Ms. Melanie Hermes. Also present were Municipal Manager Evonne Kovach and Acting Clerk of Council David Lumsden.

MOMENT OF SILENT REFLECTION/PRAYER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG

After a prayer led by Mr. Drees, the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was recited.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

The Mayor invited proposals from Council members on proposed entryway signage design and materials.

Mr. Halter presented a proposal for entry signage. His design was inspired by the original entry signage to the Village. Mr. Drees inquired about the visibility of some of the lettering or text colors. Mr. Halter said the lettering would be reflective. The sign would be brown polymer with white lettering. He stated that the signage would be affordable compared to cast metal materials. Placement of the sign on the northern end of Winton would require an easement onto the Baptist Church's property.



Ms. Waltherr reminded Council of the upcoming Community Day at the Greenhills Swimming Pool on Saturday, August 25th, 2018.


Mr. Drees welcomed the new Finance Director and asked about the process of replacement of the Clerk of Council.
