MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Moore called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Councilmembers Glenn Drees, Jeff Halter, Melanie Hermes, Jack Lee, Natashia Metz and Maria Waltherr. Also present were Municipal Manager Evonne Kovach, Police Chief Neil Ferdelman and Acting Clerk of Council David Lumsden.

MOMENT OF SILENT REFLECTION/PRAYER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG

Following a prayer led by Ms. Waltherr, the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States was recited.

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

Election of President Pro Tem and Vice President Pro Tem

Ms. Waltherr moved to appoint Ms. Hermes as President Pro Tem. Mr. Lee seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Ms. Hermes moved to appoint Ms. Waltherr as Vice President Pro Tem. Mr. Lee seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Mayor's Announcement of Appointments to Council Standing Committees

There are no changes to the existing Council Standing Committees.

Motion to Concur with Mayor's Appointments to Boards and Commissions

Ms. Waltherr moved to appoint Robert Howell, 34 Damon Road, to the Recreation Commission and Waycross Community Programming Board. Ms. Hermes seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Motion to Adopt the Rules of Council

Mr. Drees moved to adopt the Rules of Council as written. Ms. Waltherr seconded.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Recent police activity in the Village

Chief Ferdelman briefed Council on the police activity around the Village today. It occurred after an incident involving several suspects on foot along the eastern edge of the Village. All the suspects have been apprehended.

Greenhills Golf Course

Ms. Kovach said \$40,000 is currently appropriated for the Golf Course in 2019. A Service Department employee is maintaining the course currently. Some interest has been expressed in hiring an additional employee to promote the course.

A job posting for a marketing professional and a request for creative utilization proposals have both been prepared. Council reviewed the proposed job postings prepared by Ms. Kovach and discussed the plan of operation for the Greenhills Golf Course.

Additional items that may be brought before Council by its members.

Ms. Hermes reviewed the Council meeting calendar for 2019 and proposed rescheduling the December Regular Meeting for Dec. 10th and cancelling the Dec. 24th meeting. All members were in favor.

Ms. Metz said that the Village Council and administration is aware of issues with the water main replacement project and are working to best resolve them. Mayor Moore encouraged residents to call Greater Cincinnati Water Works with any concerns or complaints about the project.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mr. Drees moved to enter Executive Session to discuss compensation and employment of public employees, with no business to follow the Executive Session. Ms. Hermes seconded. Council adjourned into Executive Session at 7:45 p.m. At 9:18 p.m., Mr. Drees moved to adjourn out of Executive Session. Ms. Hermes seconded.
