

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-34-F

ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR PART TIME POLICE OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenhills has previously set the wage for part time police officers at the rate of three-quarters (3/4) the pay scale of full-time field personnel, and

WHEREAS, part time police officer positions are important to the overall staffing of the Greenhills Police Department and the wage paid directly impacts the Village's ability to attract and retain qualified part time officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio.

SECTION 1.

That the compensation for part time police officers be within a range of \$15.50 to \$19.00, depending on qualifications at the time of hiring.

SECTION 2.

That any portions of previous legislation passed by Village Council in conflict with this new compensation rate are hereby superseded by this resolution.

SECTION 3.

That any part time officer currently employed by Greenhills and making less than the minimum established by this resolution shall have their salary increased to reflect this new range.

SECTION 4.

That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
