Valuables Stolen from Cars in A & B Sections

Multiple cases of thefts from vehicles on the west side of Greenhills have been reported. The first occurred on Monday, April 29th, and all of the others happened in the early morning hours this past weekend. Streets involved include the first block of Andover Road, the first and second blocks of Burley Circle, and Bachman Street:

- The April 29th incident occurred on Andover Road and involved the theft of a recently purchased handgun, and a large sum of cash. The stolen weapon has been entered into the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) system;
- The next theft on Andover most likely occurred between 1:30 and 2 AM early Sunday morning when dogs were heard barking. The next morning the car's owner found that the glove box had been opened and articles were scattered around. The only thing that appears to be taken was some loose change;
- The theft in the first block of Burley also included only coins and the glove box and center console were opened;
- The theft from the second block of Burley resulted in the theft of valuable designer sunglasses, a GPS device, and a collectible coffee cup;
- On Bachman, the vehicle's center console was ransacked, and only loose change was taken. The car alarm was heard sounding around 2 AM.

In every case except one, all of the vehicles were reportedly left unlocked. In all cases, there was no signs of forced entry into the vehicles.

Residents are asked to:

- **Lock their vehicles when leaving them overnight!**
- **Never, ever leave valuables unattended in a locked or unlocked car!**
- **If you hear something, say something! Call 911 at that time so an officer can come to investigate!**

We will be on the lookout for possible suspects, but if you see or hear anything in your neighborhood, please call us so we can check it out. If you live in this area and have video surveillance around your home, please check your footage and let us know if you see something that looks suspicious.
