

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-56-F

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO AWARD THE 2011
INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE VILLAGE OF GREENHILLS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the insurance for the Village of Greenhills will expire on January 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary the Village of Greenhills have continuous insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, Wells Fargo Insurance Services USA, Inc. has submitted the best bid, locking in a rate for three years.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by Council for the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio, 6 members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1.

That the insurance policies written by Wells Fargo Insurance Services USA, Inc. for the issuance of automobile, general liability, police professional liability, public officials liability, property insurance, and other insurance as determined by the Municipal Manager in the name of the Village of Greenhills, is hereby awarded in an amount not to exceed Forty-two Thousand dollars (\$42,000.00) per year, for three years. A copy of the policy is on file with the Finance Director.

SECTION 2.

The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to implement said coverage.

SECTION 3.

The expenditure of an amount not to exceed Forty-two Thousand Dollars (\$42,000.00) for each policy year of 2011, 2012, and 2013 is hereby authorized and directed by the Municipal Manager.

SECTION 4.

Wells Fargo Insurance Services USA, Inc. is hereby authorized to render professional consultation with respect to insurance coverage for 2011, 2012, and 2013.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare and shall take effect immediately. The reason for said emergency is the need to continue insurance coverage which will expire January 1, 2011.
