

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-58-S&S

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDSTHROUGH THE ASH REMOVAL AND CANOPY RESTORATION GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the quality of urban life is enhanced by the proper management of the urban forest resources, and

WHEREAS, Greenhills recognizes the importance of providing tree and shrub related benefits to all citizens, and

WHEREAS, funding for the removal of ash trees and the purchase and installation of replacement trees is available through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (Ash Removal and Canopy Restoration Grant), and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1.

That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to administer a Ash Removal and Canopy Restoration Grant, and that Evonne Kovach is authorized to sign said agreement.

SECTION 2.

That the Council of the Village of Greenhills hereby requests the Department of Natural Resources to consider and fund this Ash Removal and Canopy Restoration Grant project.

SECTION 3.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 1211.232 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4.

That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate public peace, health, safety and welfare and shall take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for said emergency is the need to meet the filing deadline.
