

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-13-F

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CERTAIN POSITIONS,
MODIFYING CURRENT POSITIONS AND
SETTING RATES OF PAY FOR CERTAIN POSITIONS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

Be it Ordained by Council for the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1.

The position of Clerk of Court is hereby confirmed as a full time position retroactive to December 1, 2010, with a rate of pay set at \$16.75 per hour, said rate to take effect upon successful completion of the employee's probationary period.

SECTION 2.

A Part Time Fiscal Officer position is created retroactive to March 14, 2011 with a rate of pay set at \$25.00 per hour, with said rate to take effect upon successful completion of the employee's probationary period.

SECTION 3.

A Service Foreman position is hereby created and a current employee of Greenhills will be promoted to that position effective April 10, 2011 with a rate of pay set at \$20.00 per hour.

SECTION 4.

Effective April 10, 2011, Police Officer Robert Dean will receive a pay grade increase from \$22.74 to \$23.85 per hour; Police Officer Timothy Lukes will receive a pay grade increase from \$20.20 to \$22.22 per hour; Police Officer Andrew Moore will receive a pay grade increase from \$20.20 to \$21.18 per hour.

SECTION 5.

The position of Executive Assistant to the Municipal Manager/Assistant Property Manager shall be designated an hourly non-exempt position effective April 10, 2011, with a rate of pay set at \$18.75 per hour.

SECTION 6.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare and shall take effect immediately. The reason for said emergency is the need to establish rates of pay at the earliest possible date for the uninterrupted provision of services.
