

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-18-S&S**

**AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,850.91 FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE VILLAGE BUCKET TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS,** the Village of Greenhills currently owns one bucket truck which is the Village's primary means of addressing branches and limbs hanging of the rights of way after storms, and dealing with sign and light damage; and

**WHEREAS,** recently, the bucket truck was determined to be inoperable due to mechanical failures; and

**WHEREAS,** having an operational bucket truck is critical to the Village due to the number of large mature trees that have and continue to sustain damage from recent storms; and

**WHEREAS,** Impact Fleet Services, Inc. has performed emergency repairs to the bucket truck in order to render the vehicle operational and available for immediate use for the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio, 5 members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.**

That payment in the amount of \$10,850.91 is hereby authorized for emergency repair services rendered by Impact Fleet Services, Inc.

**SECTION 2.**

That the Municipal Manager is further authorized to execute any necessary documents to finalize payment for said emergency repair services.

**SECTION 3.**

That the Finance Officer is hereby authorized to pay an amount not to exceed \$10,850.91 to Impact Fleet Service, Inc. pursuant to the invoice submitted by Impact Fleet Services, Inc. for said repairs.

**SECTION 4.**

This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be effective immediately upon passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need authorize timely payment for emergency repair services in order to keep the Village bucket truck operational and available for its critical use.
