

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-24-S&S**

**AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO  
A CONTRACT WITH HENDY INC. AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Greenhills is participating in Hamilton County's Community Development Block Grant Program and has received funding through this program for 2011 to be used specifically for the construction of a sidewalk along Winton Road; and

**WHEREAS**, Hendy Inc. submitted the lowest and best bid following a competitive bid process – said bid being subject to the review and approval of the Hamilton County Community Development Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio, 6 members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.**

That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Hendy Inc., contingent upon the approval of the contractor by the Hamilton County Community Development Office, in the amount of \$66,390 for the construction of the Winton Road Sidewalk Project. The contract will be in the form incorporated into the Specifications and Bidding Documents, by reference made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2.**

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village. The reason for said emergency is to take advantage of the lowest bid amount and begin construction at the soonest possible date.
