

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-34-S&S

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FORD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO A WINTON ROAD STORM SEWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on Sunday, July 17, 2011 a sink hole was discovered in Winton Road and on Monday, July 18, 2011 the storm sewer line located in the vicinity was televised, the result of which indicated a total deterioration of the bottom of the existing storm sewer and the potential for a total collapse of that portion of the road; and

WHEREAS, Ford Development Corporation was contacted to provide steel plates to protect the vehicular traffic and to provide an estimate of cost to replace the storm sewer and repair the road; and

WHEREAS, emergency funding is being sought from Hamilton County's Municipal Road Funds to aid the Village in covering a portion of this emergency expense;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio, and 6 members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1.

That the Municipal Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Ford Development Corporation for emergency storm sewer and road repair services needed to address a sinkhole on Winton Road.

SECTION 2.

That the fiscal officer is hereby authorized to pay an amount of \$13,800.00 to Ford Development Corporation for emergency storm sewer replacement and road repairs on Winton Road; and

SECTION 3.

This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and shall be effective immediately upon passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to repair infrastructure that is currently unsafe.
