

**ORDINANCE NO. 2012-11-F**

**ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNUAL PERMANENT  
APPROPRIATION FOR 2012**

An Ordinance to make permanent appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2012 pursuant to Exhibit A: Permanent Appropriation for 2012 (dated 3/6/12) attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Greenhills during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2012, the following sums be and they are hereby, set aside and appropriated as follows, namely:

Section 1. That there be appropriated from the GENERAL FUND \$1,795,873.00 (which amount includes Advances and Transfers as listed in Sections 6 and 7 below).

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS \$1,608,555.00.

Section 3. That there be appropriated from the DEBT/BOND RETIREMENT FUND \$653,705.00.

Section 4. That there be appropriated from the SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FUND \$50,000.00.

for a GRAND TOTAL OF \$4,108,133.00 for all funds.

Section 5. And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 6. This ordinance includes the following transfers up to the following amounts:

From the General Fund to the Swimming Pool	\$ 20,000
From the General Fund to the Golf Course	\$ 10,000
From the General Fund to the Non-voted Debt Fund	\$325,762

Section 7. The ordinance includes the following advance up to the following amount:

From the General Fund to the Apartments	\$ 45,000
