

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-34-F

**AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH ANTHEM FOR PROVIDING HEALTH INSURANCE
COVERAGE FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENHILLS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenhills provides health insurance benefits for eligible employees; and

WHEREAS, the Village has requested and reviewed proposals for health insurance benefits from various carriers and determined that the proposal submitted by Anthem is the best proposal for the Village in terms of quality, service, and adaptability.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio,
6 members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1.

That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Anthem for the purpose of providing health insurance benefits for its employees for a term commencing August 1, 2012 until July 31, 2013.

SECTION 2.

That the annual premium with Anthem shall be \$86,271.00, plus or minus qualifying changes during the term of coverage, and that said amount is hereby authorized to be paid.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the municipality and shall take effect upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is to provide uninterrupted health insurance benefits for Village employees.
