

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-26-F

**RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO PROCEED WITH PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS
REGARDING SHADE TREES**

WHEREAS, following the adoption of Resolution No. 2014-17F declaring the necessity for public improvements within the Greenhills Forestry District, no objections to the assessments have been filed; and

WHEREAS, since no objections were filed, there are no reports from an assessment equalization board to consider as required by Ohio Revised Code Section 727.23;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1.

It is the intention of this Council to proceed with the improvements in accordance with the provisions set forth in the resolution of necessity being number 2014-17-F.

SECTION 2.

The assessment of all lots determined to be specifically benefited by said improvements set forth in Resolution 2014-17-F is hereby authorized. The assessment shall be fifty cents (\$.50) per front foot. Lots having frontage on more than one side, including corner lots, shall be computed at 75% of the total lot frontage. The maximum assessment per single family residence shall not exceed \$60.00 annually.

SECTION 3.

There are no claims for damages to be judicially determined before granting the proposed improvement.

SECTION 4.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
