

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-27-S&S

AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BARRETT PAVING AND ADLETA, INC. FOR THE WINTON ROAD PHASE II REHABILITATION PROJECT AND WATER MAIN PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenhills desires to make road improvements to Winton Road from the intersection of Farragut/Cromwell and Winton south to the corporation line with water main improvements being made by, and funded by, the Greater Cincinnati Water Works at the same time; and

WHEREAS, Greater Cincinnati Water Works will be depositing the dollar amount of the Greater Cincinnati Water Works contract with the Village for disbursement; and

WHEREAS, Greenhills has received grant funds from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) to use in combination with local funds for the road improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the Village sought bids from qualified vendors for said projects; and

WHEREAS, bids for said project were received by the Village on August 27, 2014, and Barrett Paving and Adleta, Inc. submitted the lowest and best bids for the road improvements and the water improvements, respectively, following the competitive bid process and the Village Engineer CDS Associates are recommending contracts for said projects based on the bids they submitted; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1.

That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Barrett Paving in the approximate amount of \$660,282.14 for the road improvement project.

SECTION 2.

That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to draw funds from OPWC and make payments of local matching dollars in a total amount of \$660,282.14 to Barrett Paving, pursuant to the terms of said contract.

SECTION 3.

That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Adleta, Inc. in the approximate amount of \$196,968.10 for the water main project.

SECTION 4.

That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to make payments from the funding provided by the Greater Cincinnati Water Works in the amount of \$196,968.10 to Adleta, Inc. pursuant to the terms of said contract.

SECTION 5.

That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
