

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-23-L&R

**REAFFIRMING THE POSITION OF A LETTER OF OPPOSITION TO A PROPOSED
CENTRALIZED COLLECTION OF NET PROFIT TAX RETURNS AND OTHER
PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX**

WHEREAS, it is proposed in the State's Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Operating Budget to institute a State controlled program for the centralized collection of local municipal income tax; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenhills is strongly opposed to revisions on municipal tax collection that decreases local control and flexibility while increasing the size of an overreaching centralized State government at the expense of local government; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenhills is opposed to additional requirements and unnecessary burdensome bureaucracy and demands imposed to the benefit of special interest groups; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Greenhills expressed such opposition in a letter dated April 11, 2017, attached; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio.

SECTION 1.

That the Council of the Village of Greenhills does hereby reaffirm its opposition to the proposed centralized collection of net profit tax returns and other provisions related to municipal income tax as expressed in the aforementioned letter.

SECTION 2.

That the Ohio General Assembly should request the immediate removal of all language pertaining to municipal income tax collection and administration.

SECTION 3.

That this Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
