

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-20-F**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX  
IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION (POLICE OPERATING)**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to continue to provide the residents of Greenhills with necessary governmental services, and

**WHEREAS**, in order to further the **providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, or for the payment of other related costs for the Village** it is necessary to add an additional levy; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mills limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Greenhills, Hamilton County, Ohio, and

**WHEREAS**, the Hamilton County Auditor has certified to the Village Council that the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a levy of tax at a rate not exceeding 3.50 mills for each one hundred thousand dollar market valuation equals \$122.50 based upon the total estimated tax valuation of the Village of \$52,785,510; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to submit the 3.50 mill additional levy to the electors of the Village at the general election to be held on November 6, 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Hamilton County, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.**

That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Greenhills, pursuant to ORC §5705.19(J), for the primary purpose and intent of such funding is for providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, or for the payment of other related costs for the Village as authorized by §5705.19 (J) of the Ohio Revised Code within the municipality at a rate not exceeding 3.50 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$122.50 for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a continuing period of time and which levy is an additional levy of 3.50 mills.

**SECTION 2.**

That the question of the additional levy be submitted to the electors of said Village of Greenhills at the November election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Greenhills on the 6th day of November, 2018.

**SECTION 3.**

That said tax levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

**SECTION 4.**

That the Clerk of the Village of Greenhills be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections, Hamilton County, Ohio and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

**SECTION 5.**

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6.**

That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
