

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R04-F

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING INFORMATION FROM THE HAMILTON COUNTY AUDITOR FOR PURPOSES
OF EVALUATING AND LEVYING A TAX EXCEEDING THE 10-MILL LIMITATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Village Council has preliminarily determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the 10-mill limitation will be insufficient to fund necessary services provided by the Village of Greenhills, Hamilton County, Ohio, and
- WHEREAS,** the primary purpose and intent of such funding is for the general construction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the municipal corporation as authorized by §5705.19 (G) of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- WHEREAS,** ORC §5705.03 requires the Village Council to obtain certain information from the County Auditor prior to proceeding with the submission of an additional tax levy to the electors of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio:

- SECTION 1.** That the Village Council has preliminarily determined that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the 10-mill limitation for the benefit of the residents of Greenhills for the general construction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the municipal corporation as authorized by ORC §5705.19 (G) for a period of five (5) years.
- SECTION 2.** That the renewal levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Greenhills, Hamilton County, at the November general election to be held at the usual places within said Village of Greenhills on the 5th day of November, 2024.
- SECTION 3.** That said levy shall be placed upon the tax lists for 2024 for collection in 2025 if the majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.
- SECTION 4.** That the Village Council hereby requests information from the County Auditor related to the current total tax valuation of the Village and they dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a levy of tax at a rate not exceeding 1.50 mills for each One Dollar (\$1) valuation for five years.
- SECTION 5.** That the Village Council seeks the information request to present the levy on the November 5th ballot.
- SECTION 6.** That the Clerk of the Village Council is hereby directed to immediately certify to the County Auditor this resolution and to obtain from the County Auditor the information requested hereunder.
- SECTION 7.** That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
